


## Clicker 5 Quick Start Guide

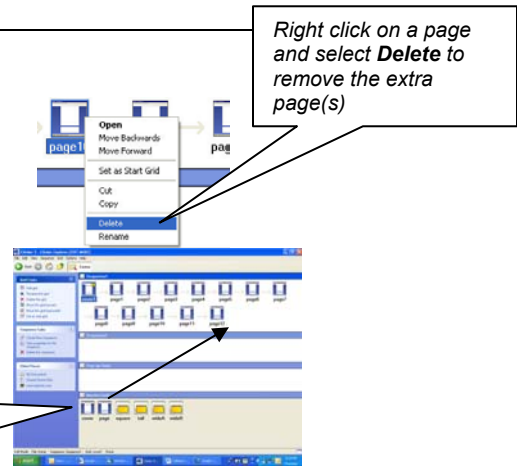
Creating books that are accessible for all students is easy to do in Clicker 5. The program comes with templates that can be customized with pictures and text to create interactive talking books. This Quick Start Guide describes how to make this type of book.

Creating a Talking Book	
<b>1</b>	<p>Launch the Clicker 5 program – from ClickerExplorer...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• select <b>Create New Grid Set</b> from the Clicker 5 Tasks menu in the upper left hand corner</li> <li>• Choose a template from the <b>Book Making</b> template folder.</li> </ul>
<b>2</b>	<p>With your template open, go into <b>Edit Mode</b> from the <b>Edit</b> menu to modify the template; add text, images, or anything else you wish to include on the page's text box(s) and cell(s). Elements may be added or removed at this time as desired.</p>
<b>3</b>	<p>Some of the standard elements of the Book Making templates are shown here. Decide to include or eliminate any of the elements based on the book you are creating.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between; align-items: flex-start;"> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; width: 60%;"> <p><i>By default, when this button is clicked on it will read the text located within the textbox on the page. However, if a sound is recorded using the button above, that sound will be played instead of the textbox content. Removing this button will ensure the user hears the textbox content only.</i></p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> the reader may still hear the individual words by clicking on them at any time.</p> </div> <div style="width: 35%;">  <p><i>This button allows the reader or teacher to record and save an audio file.</i></p> </div> </div> <p style="text-align: center; margin-top: 10px;">Page Navigation</p>

Add more pages or delete extra pages by clicking on the **Explorer** button while in Edit Mode.

Drag a template from the **Master Grids** pane into the **Sequence1** pane in the appropriate place among the existing pages.

When you have completed your Talking Book, select **Save Grid Set** from the **File** drop down menu and give it an appropriate name. Your book is now ready to be used.

**NOTE:** it is always a good idea to save your work periodically during any modifications so your work is not lost should anything happen to your computer.
