Managing Kurzweil 3000 Files

Suggested Activities

Once you have completed the tutorial, try these activities to practice managing the different types of Kurzweil 3000 files...

1. Create a new text file. Format the document as you would like. Save the file as a Microsoft Word document. Open that document up in Word to see if there are any formatting changes.
2. Scan a few pages from a book. Add a few notes or annotations to the document. Save it as a rich text document and note what happens.
3. Try opening other compatible document types in Kurzweil 3000. Open a .pdf and a .jpg picture. Compare the original with how it is displayed in the Kurzweil program.
4. Experiment with converting other types of files using the KESI Virtual Printer. Note which files will convert and which won't. You might try converting an Inspiration web, for example, or a text document created with some program other than MS Word.
5. Keep track of your experiments in note form – these notes will come in handy as you are using the program with your student(s).
