

# Read&Write for Google Chrome – Translator

## Introduction

The Translator feature allows the user a quick way to look up, and listening to the translation of words. These include English, French, Spanish, Nederlands, Bahasa Melayu, and Portugues (Brasileira), and more are in development.

- Translating a word into a one of language options.



## This tutorial assumes:

- Access to the internet.


## Case Study

Aida is a student whose first language is French. She is learning English, but is struggling to comprehend text while reading directions, and conducting research on the web. She has access to the Read&Write toolbar and uses the Translator tool to look up the translation of certain words she does not know.

## Translator using Read & Write for Google Chrome

<p>1</p>	<p>Open a web page in your Chrome Browser. <p>6</p>	<p>Select a word to translate (1).</p> <p>Click the <i>Translator</i> icon (2).</p>	
<p>7</p>	<p>A window will appear with the translated word.</p> <p>Click on the <i>Play</i> icon to listen to the word (1).</p>
