Using SMART RECORDER

Introduction

Smart Recorder allows you to record what you do on the smartboard to replay at a later date. Add images, text, sounds and hyperlinks to a lesson to demonstrate a concept that students can play and replay to solidify comprehension. Alternatively, have students make their own presentations using Smart Notebook software.

- Recording a Smart Notebook lesson for replay at later date.




This tutorial assumes...

Case Study

Colin wants to explore the concept of a flipped classroom where students view pre-recorded lessons then complete work with his support during class time. In using the Smart Recorder, he realizes that potential of students using the tool for presentations to represent their knowledge also.

Step 1: Customizing toolbars to find Smart Recorder

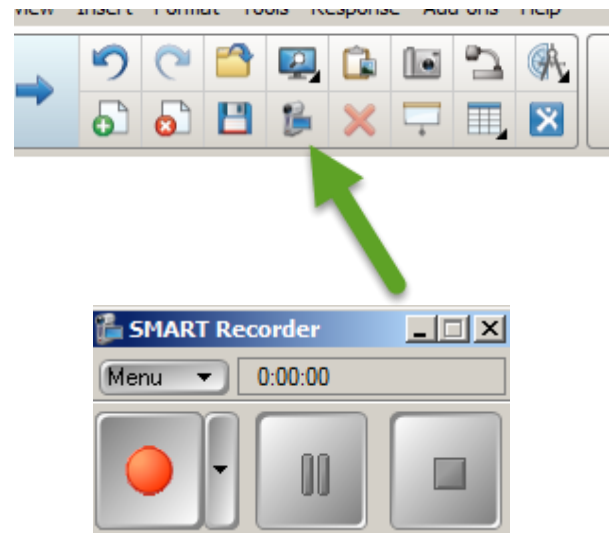
<p>1</p>	<p>Use drop-down View menu to locate Toolbar Options and select Customize Toolbar.</p>	
<p>2</p>	<p>From the Customize Toolbar window that appears, drag and drop SMART Recorder to the toolbar at the top of the screen.</p>	
<p>3</p>	<p>SMART Recorder should now appear among the tools available to you.</p>	

Step 2: Using the SMART Recorder

Select the **SMART recorder**. A recording window will open.

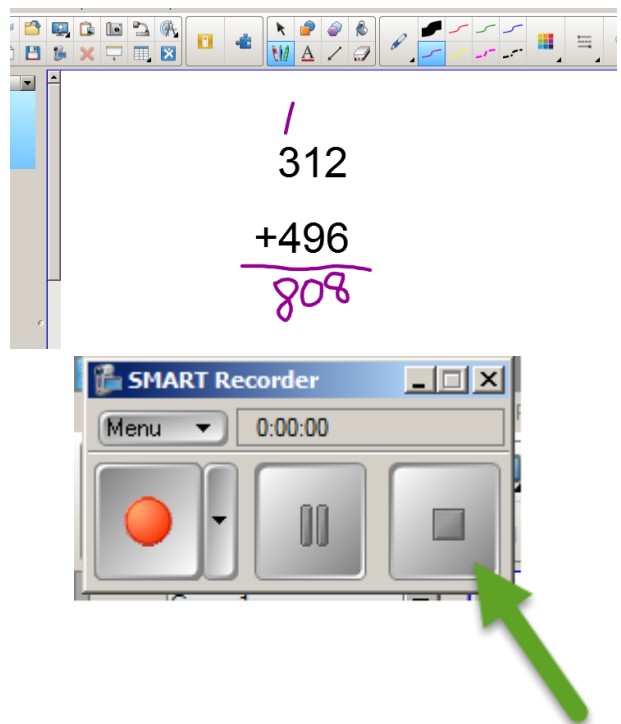
Press the red **record button** when you are ready to begin.





Complete the lesson that you are teaching with recorder running.

Press stop when you are finished with your lesson or demonstration.



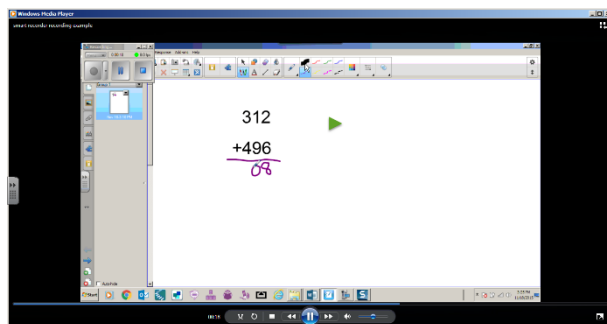
<p>3</p>	<p>You will be asked to save your recording. Provide a file name and select the location to save the file.</p>	
<p>4</p>	<p>Upon pressing save, SMART Recorder will create a .wmv video file and save it. .Wmv files and play with Windows Media Player.</p>	

Step 3: Playing your SMART recording.

<p>1</p>	<p>Locate the SMART recording to where it was saved on your computer. Open the file by clicking on the file name.</p>

The recording will play using Windows Media Player.
