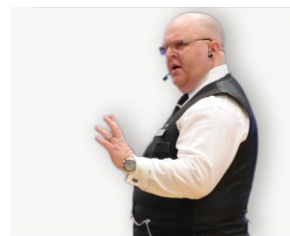


We are happy to have Darren back on December 5th from 1:00 pm - 3:30 pm for another session on Internet Safety for Educators!
