

SET-BC will reimburse school districts or schools for the purchase of SET-BC supported iApps which have been identified at the Collaborative Action Plan meeting or requested, at a later date, by school team members in consultation with their SET-BC consultant.

IMPORTANT!

A current list of iApps that SET-BC supports and will provide iTunes purchase reimbursement can be found under iPads / iPods Loans here: www.setbc.org/support/default.html. SET-BC will **ONLY** provide school district or school reimbursement for those iApps listed here and which have been identified as being required through consultation with the SET-BC consultant. The school team is responsible for accessing the necessary iTunes account, locating, and installing the iApp.

Once the iApp has been purchased and installed, school districts or schools should follow these instructions to be reimbursed:

1. Forward the electronic iTunes receipt for the iApp to John Drescher (jdrescher@setbc.org).
2. In the email, include the following information:
 - a. Student's name
 - b. Name of school district or school (cheque payable to)
 - c. School district or school address and phone number

The request for reimbursement will be reviewed and a cheque will be mailed out to the school district or school name indicated.
