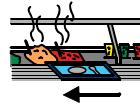




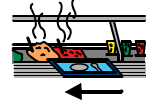
Lunchtime at School

have my lunch in the cafeteria with my



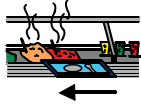
friends and with SEAs. In the cafeteria

friends and with the support workers at

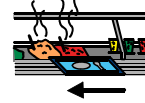


lunchtime.



All these SEAs have special jobs

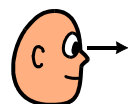
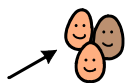
to do. They are working to support

their own. I am always welcome to sit



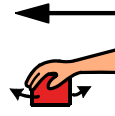
with them at lunchtime. They like to see



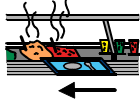
me enjoying myself at lunch. I don't need



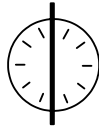
their help, but I like their company.



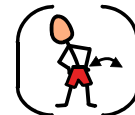
I used to have to walk to



the cafeteria with an SEA.



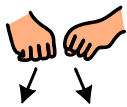
Now, I am old enough to walk on



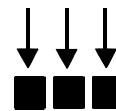
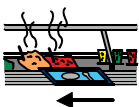
my own. I walk on my own to PE and



my teacher is very proud of me. I



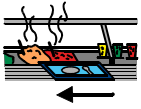
can try to walk on my own to the
