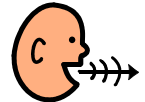
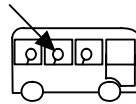
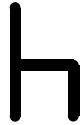
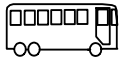
Sometimes I ride the bus to go to school,

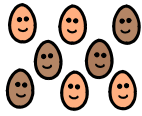
Bus stops, bus stations and buses are public places.



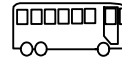
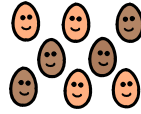
When people are in public places like the bus, they usually



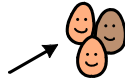
like to have a little bit of space between them and other
