

## Talking Books Camp: Learning Objectives

### Section 1: Getting your book-making Clicker template ready

Student will successfully:

- open sample talking book
- navigate talking book
- close talking book

### Section 2: Selecting a topic for the book

Student will successfully:

- locate files on the computer
- choose between a variety of topics to write about
- open the folder for the chosen topic
- be able to talk about or respond to questions regarding the pictures in the chosen topic

### Section 3: Set up a talking book.

Student will:

- open talking book template
- save template with a title that reflects the topic (i.e. Butterfly Book)
- determine if they will create a book with:
  - pictures and sounds or
  - pictures and text or
  - pictures with recorded voice
- move between edit and run mode in the “Click and Edit” template

### Section 4: Importing images and sounds into Clicker 6 cells

Student will successfully:

- use image insert tool to bring images into Clicker cells
- use the sound icon to navigate to saved sound files and import into Clicker cell

### Section 5: Add text to the talking book (if appropriate – based on student level)

Student will successfully:

- type words and sentences into the textbox on each grid in the gridset
- click on the sound icon to have the text read aloud

## Section 6: Add their own voice to the talking book

Student will successfully:

- use the 'record/speak' cell to record the story on each grid in the gridset
- click on the 'record/speak' cell to have the recording played

## Section 8: Save and share the book

Student will successfully:

- save the talking book
- put the book into 'run' mode
- navigate through the book from beginning to end using the navigation buttons on each grid
- demonstrate knowledge of chosen topic
- share the talking book with others
