Suggested Activities

Once you have viewed the Kurzweil 3000 v.12 (Win) Overview presentation, try these activities to being exploring the program...

1. Open the various Sample Documents that come installed with the Kurzweil 3000 program to see the types of documents you can create with the program. Make a list of the types of documents you plan to use with your own student.
2. Create a new text file and use the tools on the Main toolbar to read the text and look up words. Use the tools on the Writing toolbar to format your document.
3. Open the Time Travel Quiz Bubble Notes documents in the Sample Documents folder and click on each Bubble note to see how each supports reading comprehension.
4. Open another image or scanned document from the Sample Documents and use the tools on the Main toolbar to read portions of the text. Explore the tools on the Study Skills toolbar and make a list of the reading and writing features that you need to learn to specifically support your student(s). Make another list of tools or features that you feel you are unlikely to use with your students.
