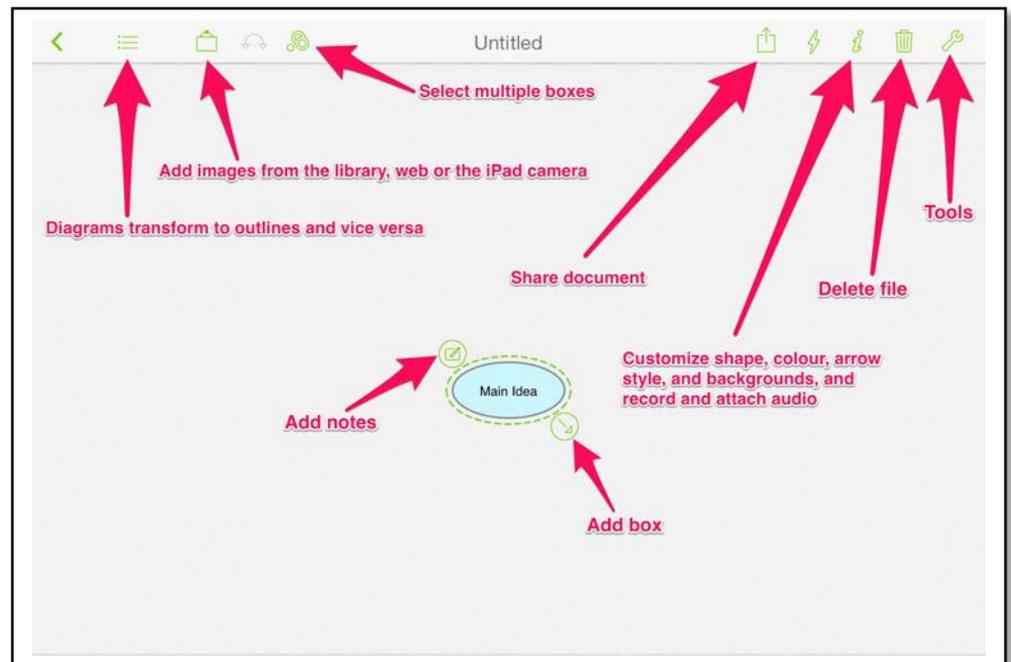
Introduction



Inspiration Maps is a visual learning app for building diagrams, graphic organizers and outlines. You can create diagrams and outlines and personalize with images, colour, shape, arrow style, and backgrounds. You can add written or audio instructions to any document. Completed documents can be shared with other apps on your iPad or with other iPads via Dropbox, AirDrop, iCloud or iTunes.

Task Challenge/Activity

- Create a new document by tapping a + sign at upper left corner.
- Enter the title “All About Me” into the Main Idea box. 25,000 Bonus points if you can figure out how to get a selfie into this idea box.
- Add six new idea boxes making sure they attach to your original box (click on the arrow on bottom right side of original).
- Title each box that you just added, “My favourite activities”, “When I grow up I want to be...”, “I am good at...”, “I like to watch...”, “My friends are...” and something of your choice. Now fill in each box with your information. If you are feeling brave, tap on the image icon and add some media from your iPad’s photo library or Inspiration Maps library to your idea boxes.
- Change the box colour, font style, font colour, link style, and background colour by tapping the **i** button on top right corner. Another 25,000 Bonus points if you can figure out how to change the shape of the idea box.
- Tap on the **Share** button (upper right hand corner) to **Save to Photos**.
