

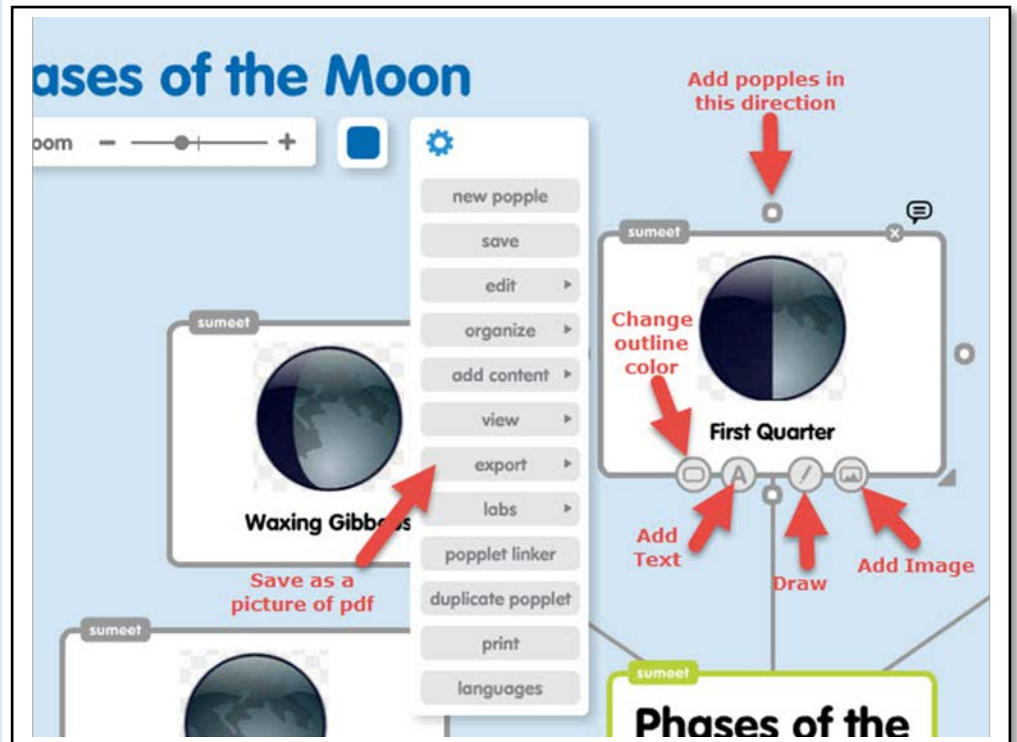
Popplet (Web-based)

Introduction

Popplet is a brainstorming tool that provides a blank canvas to capture and organize your ideas. You can add images, text, and drawings to Popples. Completed mind maps can be emailed, saved as a picture or pdf, or printed.

Task Challenge/Activity

- Create a new Popple by double-clicking on the blank canvas. Enter the title “Phases of the Moon” into this Popple. Can you figure out how to change the outline colour of the Popple?
- Add eight new Popples making sure they attach to your original Popple (click on gray circle on top, right, bottom and left sides of original, drag your cursor, and release).
- Title each Popple that you just added, “First Quarter,” “Waxing Crescent,” “New Moon,” “Waning Crescent,” “Last Quarter,” “Waning Gibbous,” “Full Moon,” and “Waxing Gibbous”.
- Now fill in each Popple with information. Try using the image icon and add some images if the corresponding phase of the moon from your computer to your Popples. You can also use the pencil tool to try drawing a picture.
- Change the background colour of your Popplet by tapping on the coloured square next to the gear icon.
- Tap on **View All** to see your completed Popplet.
- Tap on the Gear icon and hover over to **Export** to choose how to save your Popplet.
