

**ABOUT:** Participants will learn how to use Google Chrome Read&Write toolbar to enable text to speech in World Book Kids Database.

## WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

World Book Kids and the R&W toolbar



1	<p>Open <b>World Book</b> and choose <b>Kids</b>. Once article is open click on <b>Read&amp;Write purple puzzle icon</b></p>  <p>Click on the <b>Read Arrow</b> to start reading</p>	
2	<p>Click on the <b>Pause</b> to pause reading the text.</p>
