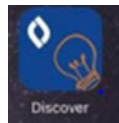


# Accessibility Tools For eBooks in Follett on iOS





**ABOUT:** In this activity, participants will learn how to use the display options, highlighting tool, and note taking on a Follett eBook on the iOS.

**WHAT YOU WILL NEED:** iPad or iPhone with iOS 10 or greater, Destiny Discover app, internet access, Follett eBook



1	<p>Open your eBook and notice the accessibility tool bar (the tool bar disappears if not used so press on the top of the book and it will re-appear)</p>	
2	<p>To change the font size, page layout and the background colour of the text press the Display Options [Aa].</p>	

<p>3</p>	<p>To access notes and highlights go to the pen and paper icon. Your notes and highlights will be displayed there.</p>	
<p>4</p>	<p>To Highlight a portion of the text, press on the area to highlight the text and the accessibility tool bar appears. Press on the highlight (pen) and choose a colour</p>	
<p>5</p>	<p>To take a note, press the area where you want to leave a note to highlight the area and the accessibility tool bar appears. Press on the Note (paper) and a small text box appears. Choose a colour for the note.</p>
