

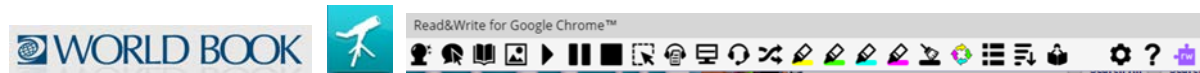
# World Book - Discover Using Google Chrome Read & Write


**ABOUT:** In this activity, participants will learn how to use Read & Write Toolbar for Text to Speech

**WHAT YOU WILL NEED:**

World Book Discover database open Log in to Read and Write using your school district email address.



1	<p>Open <b>World Book</b> and choose <b>Discover</b></p> <p>Once article is open, click on <b>Read&amp;Write purple puzzle icon</b>.</p> <p>Highlight the text and Click on the <b>Read Arrow</b> to start reading</p>	
2	<p>Click on the <b>Pause</b> to pause reading the text.</p>
