

Pronunciation, iOS 10.3.1

Introduction

When using the speak screen or speak selection function on an iPad, sometimes the word that is read back to the user may not be pronounced correctly. On an iPad, you can modify the pronunciation of a word.





This tutorial assumes

Case Study

John's class is learning about the different First Nations Group in Canada. He uses an iPad to do research and often uses the built-in speak screen function to have the website read back to him. He often notices that certain words are not pronounced correctly and he would like to have it corrected.

Modifying the Pronunciation of a word		
1	Go to Settings	
2	Go to General	
3	Go to Accessibility	
4	Go to Speech	
5	Go to Pronunciations	
6	Tap on the plus sign on the right side of the iPad	
7	Type in your phrase	

<p>8</p>	<p>Under Substitution, tap on the microphone symbol and dictate your word with the correct pronunciation</p>	
<p>9</p>	<p>Tap Done</p>	
<p>10</p>	<p>Choose the correct pronunciation from the list of provided words that are written in phonetic symbols</p>	
<p>11</p>	<p>Tap Play to hear it being spoken again.</p>	
<p>12</p>	<p>Ensure that "Apply to all apps" is toggled on</p>
