

# Predictive Text, iOS 10.3.1

## Introduction

Predictive text is an assistive feature tool that can speed up the typing process. It provides suggested words based on the letters you typed using the on screen keyboard.

- To enable predictive text on your iOS device
- To practice using the predictive text feature on your on screen keyboard




## This tutorial assumes

- that you have an iOS device (iPod, iPhone or iPad)
- that you have as a minimum, iOS8 installed on your device

## Case Study

Suzie uses an iPad in her classroom to conduct research and complete written assignments. She can get frustrated by the amount of time it takes to type her assignments and would like a faster way to input her written work.

## Using the Predictive Text feature

<p>1</p>	<p>To enable predictive text, tap on the settings icon</p>	
<p>2</p>	<p>Tap on keyboard, and ensure that predictive is toggled on</p>	
<p>3</p>	<p>Go to an app where you would likely use the on screen keyboard like Notes</p>	
<p>4</p>	<p>Tap on the screen and the on screen keyboard will appear. Input your letters and a list of suggested or predictive words will appear. Tap on the desired word and the iPad will now place that word into your document.</p>
