

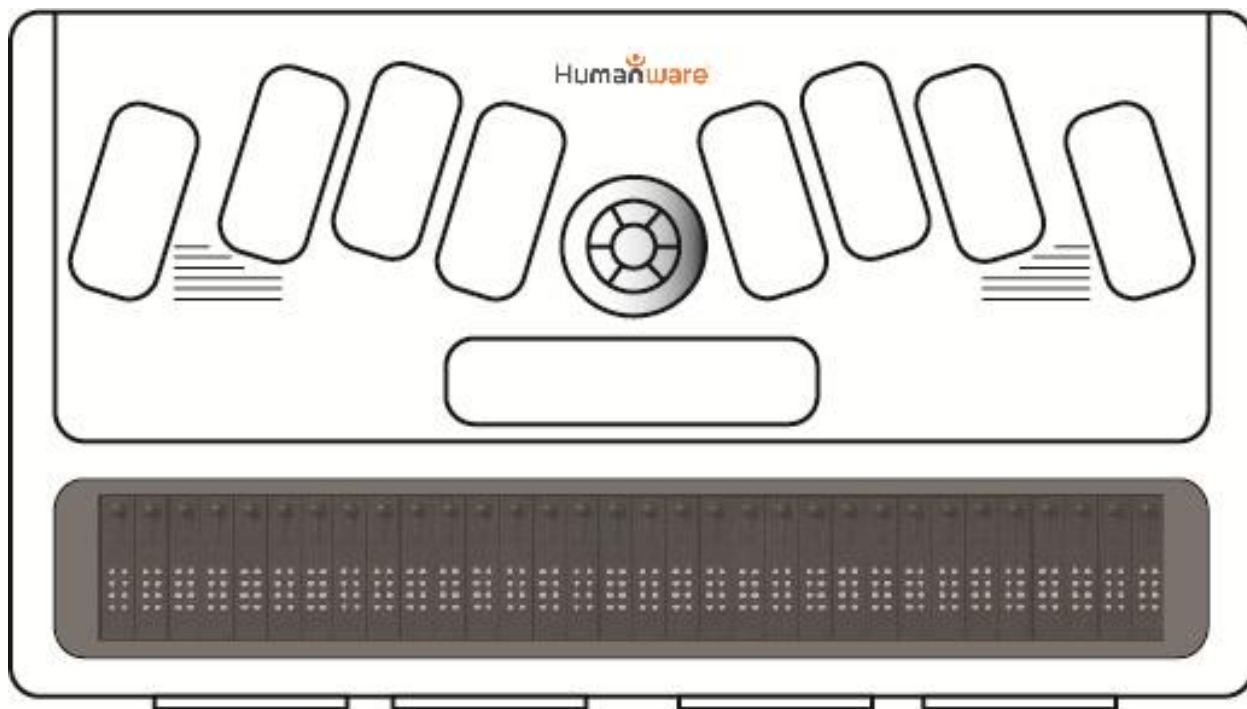
The BrailleNote APEX

The BrailleNote APEX is a fully accessible PDA, personal digital assistant, for students with visual impairments. It is portable, has speech capabilities, and a refreshable Braille display. Most commonly referred to as a Braille notetaker, the Braille Note APEX is capable of much more than word processing tasks.

The BrailleNote APEX runs on proprietary software programs which include a word processor, a scientific calculator, email client, DAISY player, address and schedule manager and several other programs.
